## Procedure:

## **DNA** gel staining procedure:

- 1. Prepare **100ml** of 0.8-3% agarose gel buffer (e.g.,1XTBE or 1XTAE or 1x FB-500) in a 250ml flask and heat in the microwave for 1~2 minutes until the agarose completely melted.
- 2. Add **5µl** of fluo-DNA gel staining solution (20,000x) into the heated agarose solution.
- 3. Swirl the flask gently to mix well and avoid forming bubbles.
- 4. Pour solution into the clean gel tray and allow the gel to cool until solidified.
- 5. Remove the comb and insert the gel into the electrophoresis chamber with1xTBE or TAE buffer or 1x FB-500 buffer.
- 6. Load DNA or RNA samples with loading buffer on the gel and perform electrophoresis.
- 7. Detect the DNA/RNA bands under UV light or blue light transilluminator/imager.
